

# 38<sup>th</sup> IVU World Vegetarian Congress 2008 at the Kulturpalast Dresden



## Additional information as of November 2007

### Speakers

### Registration fee

50% discount for students and young adults up to the age of 25; please provide an appropriate document of age. Participants from developing countries (according to the IVU list) pay 25% of the regular fee, and those from very poor countries may attend free of charge.

### Meals for accompanying persons and children

Children: under the age of 6 are free, 6-9 years of age pay 25% of the full price, 10-17 years of age pay 50% of the full price, 18 years and older pay the full price.

Accompanying persons pay 300 EUR for all meals; or 125 EUR only for lunches; or 175 EUR only for evening meals (the farewell dinner is included).

### Day tickets

You can order day tickets for the congress. Tickets for all lectures and workshops and the evening social programme are available with or without meals. These prices are valid through 30<sup>th</sup> June 2008.

An additional 10% is charged for bookings after 30 June or when purchased directly at the congress
